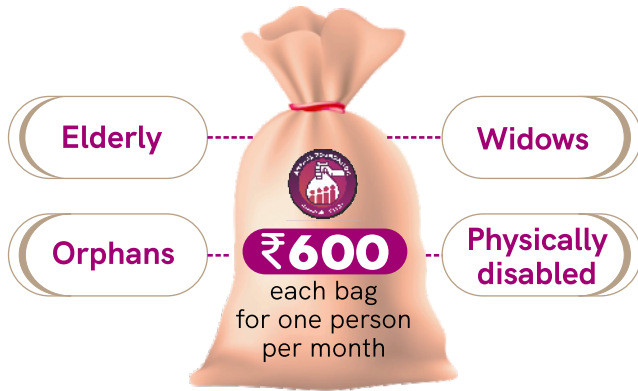
## 3 Annual Volunteer Summit

During the blessed month of Mahe Ramadhan, we collected 4,000 bags, each costing Rs 600 per person, fulfilling our target for the entire year. This achievement was made possible by the generosity and support of our community, and we are deeply thankful for everyone's contributions.



## ANFAAL FOUNDATION - CASE WORKFLOW

### 1. Request Submission via WhatsApp:

Beneficiaries can easily submit their monthly ration requests through our dedicated WhatsApp channel. This user-friendly platform allows us to promptly address their needs.

### 2. Case Preparation and Document Collection:

Our office staff will reach out to collect necessary details and documents from beneficiaries, ensuring a smooth and respectful communication process.

### 3. Verification Process:

Each case will undergo a thorough review by our on-ground verification team. This step is crucial in ensuring that assistance is directed where it is most needed.

### 4. Committee Review:

Approved cases will be discussed in our weekly committee meetings, promoting transparency and fairness in our decision-making process.

### 5. Approval Notification and Token Issuance:

Beneficiaries will receive notification of approval along with ration tokens, signifying their eligibility for assistance. Depending on family size, they will receive either 6 or 12 tokens for ration bags.

### 6. Home Delivery of Ration Bags:

Once tokens are submitted, our trusted vendors will deliver ration bags directly to beneficiaries' doorsteps, making access to essential supplies more convenient than ever.

This project, supported by our generous sponsors, is a testament to our long-term vision and commitment to education. It aims to empower beneficiaries by providing them with the knowledge and skills needed to become self-reliant and valuable assets to society.

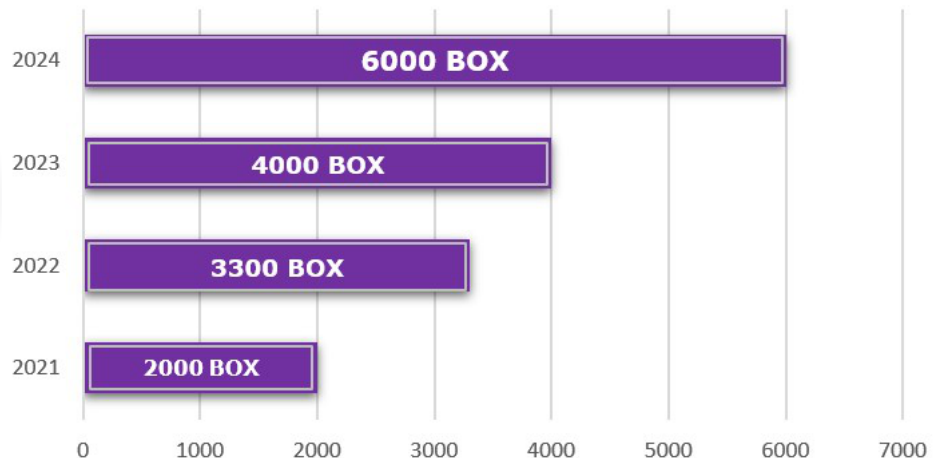


# MONTH OF AUGUST

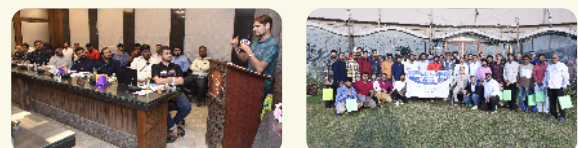

Our vision for the next decade is to produce 500 doctors and 500 IIT engineers, empowering the community and contributing to nation-building.

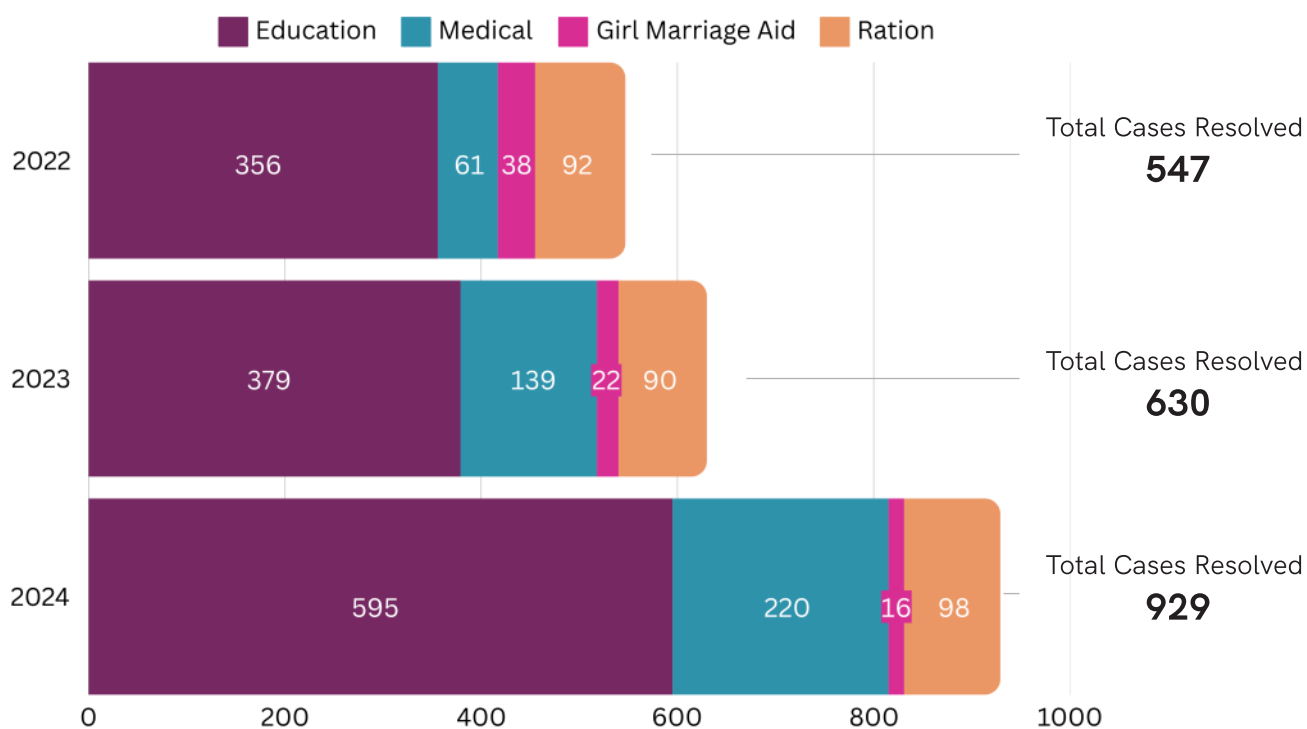


### 2 *Inspiring Minds: Trip to IIT Bombay*
